<b>Target</b>	"Have got" "Has got"
<b>Structures</b>	Possessive adjectives ; Possessive case: 'S Vocab: Family members
<b>Aim</b>	To get students to understand Possessive adjectives; Possessive case: 'S using "Have got" & "Has got".

Activity <b>Slide 10-13</b>	2	Family members flash cards	Students will see, read & learn from the Flashcards and should identify with the pictures to understand the words.	Read, display & act out Flashcards.	reading & speaking
Game <b>Slide 14</b>	10	Game; <b>Group activity</b> Family members Card-game; Conversational	Students will Ask each other these questions to match the same pairs with other players until all the pairs are matched and the game is over. Players with the most pairs win!!!	Group students & show them how to play the game. Supervise. Players with the most pairs win!!! A few prize rewards will be given to show & keep interest & motivate them.	speaking & reading & answering questions.

Dictionaries can be used as well if needed. End discussion, recap & questions.	Have students exchange papers & correct the exercise together. I'll correct them with the class by writing possible examples on the board & end with a recap of the lesson.	writing
